## ORDER

As per the Government order read as Ist paper above, Government have introduced a pilot scheme in selected ICDS blockes named "Take Home Ration Strategy" (THRS)

- As per the Government order read as 2nd paper above, directions were given to all Local Self Government Institutions for the effective implementation of the above scheme.
- Government have further examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue the guidelines as mentioned below:
  - (i) Each CDPO would calculate the cost of giving special nutrition panchayath/municipality/corporation- wise based on the number of children in each anganwadi within the village panchayath/municipality/corporation.
  - (ii) In the case of village panchayath, it will 2/3 of the estimated cost for 3 months to the CDPO. The block panchayath would remit the remaining 1/3 for all the village panchayats within the jurisdiction. Municipality and corporation will pay the full cost of three months.
  - (iii) While calculating the cost, CDPO would reduce the amount of Central Assistance (the Director of Social Welfare would indicate CDPO wise availability under Central Assistance).
  - (iv) Transportation of the food materials would be arranged by the CDPO. The cost of transportaion would be included in the total project cost (village panchayath/municipality/ corporation wise)
  - Kudumbasree units would be given fortnightly indents. Payments would be made within two days of delivery
