ORDER

As per the G.O.read above Government had approved the 'Kudumbashree Programme' for implementation from 01.11.1997. The programme aims at eradicating poverty through womens participation, both in Urban and in Rural areas in the State.

Eventhough the programme is intended to cover the whole state, Government consider that it may not be possible to implement such a massive programme during the remaining period of three months in the year 1997-98. Government therefore intend to launch the programme in the following 7 districts during the year 1997-98 and in the rest of the districts during 1998-99.

1. Kasaragod.
2. Kozhikode.
3. Wayanad.
4. Malappuram.
5. Kollam.
6. Palakkad.
7. Alappuzha.

The Director of UPA cell will initiate action for the orientation of the State and District level functionaries in the above seven districts for launching the programme during 1997-98.
